The Government of Republic of Angola has received financing in the amount of 105.5 million EUR from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (IBRD) toward the cost of the Commercial Agriculture Development Project (CADP), and it intends to apply part of the proceeds to payments for goods, works, non-consulting services and consulting services to be procured under this project. This project is jointly financed by the French Development Agency in the amount of 79 million EUR.

The Project Development Objective (PDO) is to foster commercial agriculture in Angola through a set of integrated investments in hard and soft infrastructure and to facilitate an enabling environment for private participation in the sector. The project will include the following 4 components:

Component 1: Promotion and Support for Agribusiness Development;

Component 2: Development of supporting infrastructure;

Component 3: Support for the development/improvement of the business environment and institutional strengthening and

Component 4: Project Management, Monitoring and Evaluation.
